



Financial Policies

EAR Audiology, Inc. will submit claims to your insurance company for all professional services rendered and will attempt to verify eligibility and benefits with your insurance company. However, this verification is not a guaranty of payment. Any expenses deemed not covered by your insurance company will be your financial responsibility.

All monies owed by you, such as office visit co-payments and non-covered services or products, are due at the time of service. When applicable, coinsurance percentages and/or deductibles will be collected at the time of service as well.

EAR Audiology, Inc. does not bill insurance companies for products, such as hearing aids, but will provide you with supporting information at your request so that you can directly file an insurance claim. You will provide 50% payment for products at the time of order and 50% at delivery.

It is your responsibility to provide EAR Audiology, Inc. with proof of insurance and an authorization number of referral when applicable. If these items are not provided, you will pay in full at the time of service.

EAR Audiology, Inc. accepts the following forms of payment: Visa, MasterCard, American Express, Discover, cash and personal checks. A \$20 service charge will be assessed to your account for any check returned by your bank.
